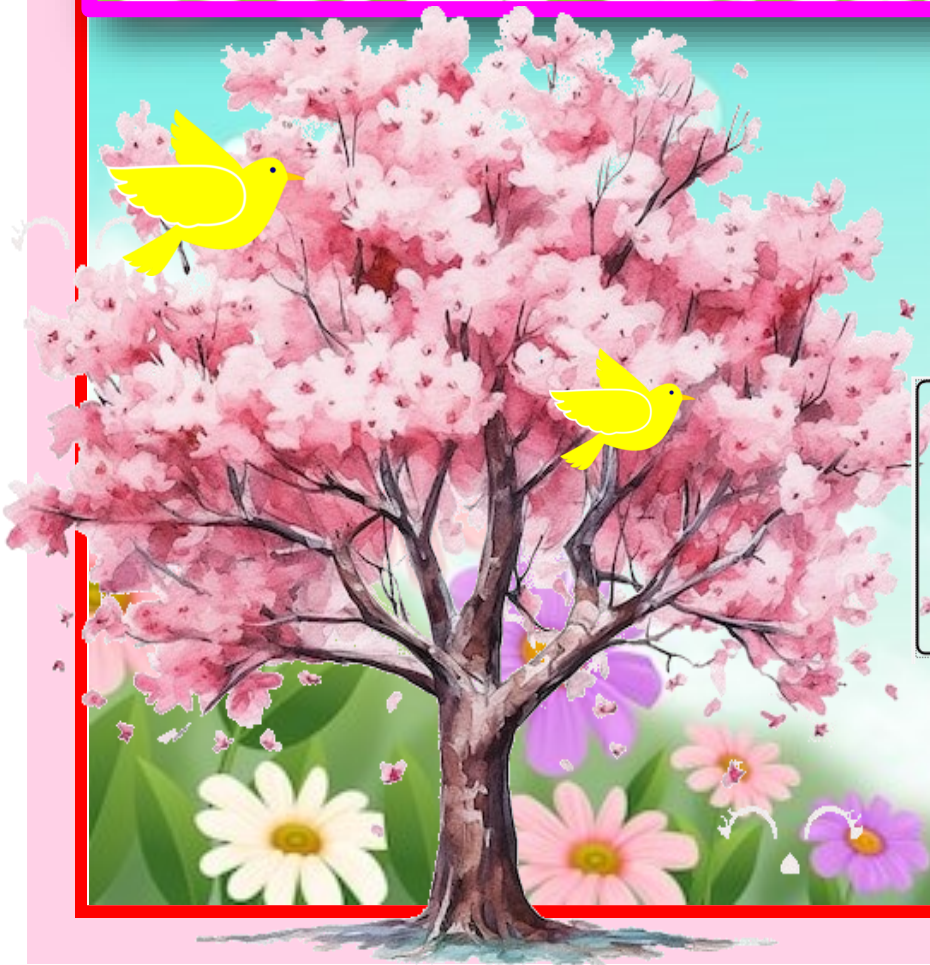

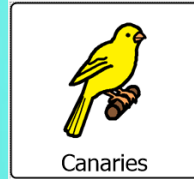

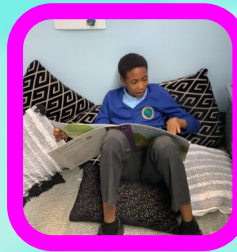


Happy New Year! We hope you all had a wonderful holiday and are prepared for the new year!

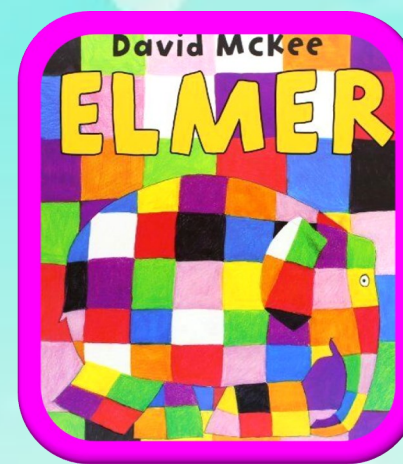
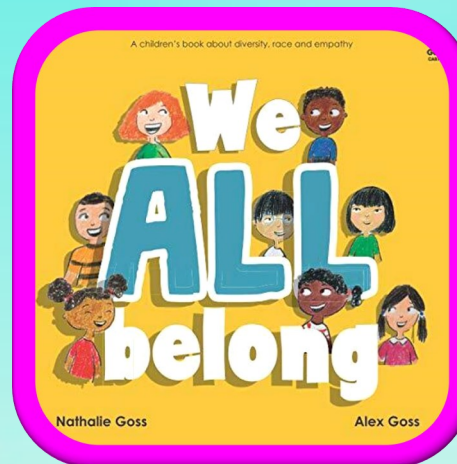
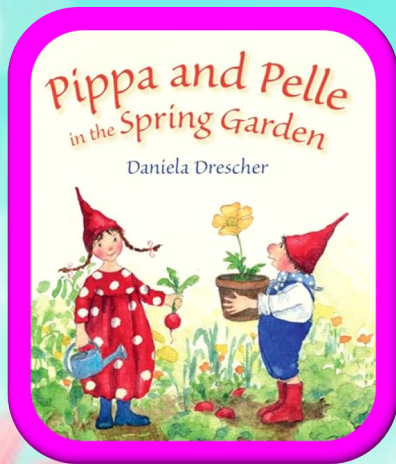

29th Good Friday and 31st Easter Sunday.



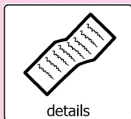
