

My Communication

- Children to learn and develop the skill to request for things they want at snack time, choose time and throughout the day. *Use of sign language, Project Core, PEC symbols, Communication boards.*
- Children to begin to answer Elkan questions with support of 2 options using symbols and real objects.
- Children to work on developing the skill to accept we sometimes have to wait.
- Children to work on following directed one step instructions such as 'shoes off.'

My Physical Well-being

- Children will be involved in different opportunities/ activities to explore movement. *Outside Play (moving around the area's, swings and climbing frame), Swings, Soft Play, Forest, Choose time (on our daily obstacle courses and soft play equipment), Swimming, ROAR Potential.*
- Children to begin to practise their balancing skills through our daily obstacle courses and staff encouraging them to use stepping stones during outside play.
- Children to explore different gross motor skills such as throwing, catching and moving their bodies in different ways.

My Outdoor School

- Children to become confident in exploring different environments and have the opportunity to experience different sounds, smells etc.
- To provide the children the opportunity to meet real farm animals
- Children to have the opportunity to explore the different farm animals and the sounds they make through a range of different activities. (cooking, art, sensory play, music, dance, songs and stories)
- Children to have the opportunity to explore the different seasons whilst adults point out the differences outside.
- Children to have the opportunity to explore the forest and be part of forest activities.

My Independence

- Children will be able to take off their own coats, shoes and socks.
- Children to work on putting on their own socks and coat (unzipped) with support from adults.
- Children to work on developing the skill to walk around the school building independently following an adult leader.

My Sensory Play

- Children will be providing lots of opportunities to explore and experience different toys and resources,
- Children to be encouraged to use toys for a purpose such as putting a ball in the ball run and watching it go down or pushing the cars across the floor.
- Children will be involved in turn taking activities during circle times to support their understanding of waiting and sharing their turn.
- Children to work on developing the ability to share toys.
- Children to begin to interact with the adults and peers in class with support.
