
Article 14 - Freedom of thought, belief and religion.

Every child has the right to think and believe what they choose and to practise their religion, as long as they are not stopping other people from enjoying their rights.


Governments must respect the rights and responsibilities of parents to guide their child as they grow up.







Their lives may be different from yours, and their worlds may be very different from yours.



















Whoever they are, whoever they are all over the world. Their smiles are like yours, And they laugh just like you.





Their place of worship may be different from yours,






But remember this: Joys are the same, and love is the same.




Smiles are the same, and hearts are just the same wherever they are, wherever you are.
